



Large-scale project grass to desert landscape application guide 2018-19

Apply at www.dwa.org/turf

Applications are now being accepted. Projects will be evaluated and accepted based on visibility and readiness to complete.

New this year

- Rebates are for **\$2** per square foot. Additional grants and funding sources are permitted.
- Large-scale (commercial and HOA) projects are limited to applying for up to 20,000 square feet/\$40,000.
- There will be a 180-day wait period to reapply for the same area.

Remaining the same

- Grass must still be in place at the time of application.
- Artificial turf will be counted as plant cover.
- **Applications are to be submitted online.** You will need to have all information compiled.
- **Incomplete applications may delay approval.**

Grant applications **must** include:

- All DWA account numbers associated with landscape areas (please check your meters/ask your landscaper)
- Contact person (Property manager, HOA board member or authorized landscaper/landscape designer)
- Mailing address for correspondence and rebate check
- Email and phone contact
- Assessor's parcel number(s) (APN)
- Map of the property with turf removal areas clearly labeled, photo of the area from the street
- Street name and closest intersection of areas with turf buy back funding requested
- Square footage of area where funding is requested (DWA will verify)
- A letter certifying that your decision-making body has approved a landscape conversion for the areas applied for
- Name on property title, lease or ownership documents
- A bid or cost estimate for the conversion
- Completed W-9 form (this is the entity that rebate check would be cut to)

Have you previously received DWA funding or approval for turf buy back? If yes, please list the amount

Is there anything that makes your project more visible that is not evident by the map? (events, nearby features, etc.)

Do you have a plan to convert areas beyond the requested rebate areas? If yes, what is the approximate square footage? If you are converting additional areas beyond application, please describe
