Petitioner/Plaintiff MISSION SPRINGS WATER DISTRICT's (Mission Springs) Petition for Writ of Mandate came on for hearing on December 9, 2021, in Department PS2 of the above-entitled Court, the Honorable Randall White, presiding. Shaun Murphy and Katelyn Empey of Slovak Baron Empey Murphy & Pinkney, LLP appeared by video on behalf of Mission Springs Water District. Having taken the matter under submission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that

- 1. Mission Springs' Petition for Administrative Mandamus (CCP § 1094.5) is denied. Judgment is entered in favor of Desert Water Agency and against Mission Springs on its First Cause of Action for Administrative Mandamus.
- 2. Mission Springs' Petition for Traditional Mandate (CCP § 1085) is denied. Judgment is entered in favor of Desert Water Agency and the Department of Water Resources and against Mission Springs on its Second Cause of Action for Traditional Mandate.
- 3. Judgment is entered in favor of Desert Water Agency and against Mission Springs on its Fifth Cause of Action for Declaratory Relief-SGMA.
- The remaining causes of action in the Third Amended Petition and Complaint in this case have been voluntarily dismissed with prejudice pursuant to a stipulation of the parties so no causes of action remain pending.
- Mission Springs' Petition for Administrative Mandamus (CCP § 1094.5) against Department of Water Resources was previously dismissed without prejudice and is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
