



## **START LATER**

Put seed down between mid-October and mid-November. This allows you to use less water to germinate.

## **CHECK YOUR SPRINKLERS**

Turn sprinklers on to make sure they are spraying the correct area.

Repair any breaks in your system. Too much water can prevent germination.

## **WATER EFFICIENTLY**

Seeds should be moist but not soaked.

Water little and often (NOT during daylight hours.)

Reduce irrigation frequency after seed sprouts.

## Skip it
