



START LATER

Put seed down between mid-October and mid-November. This allows you to use less water to germinate.

CHECK YOUR SPRINKLERS

Turn sprinklers on to make sure they are spraying the correct area.

Repair any breaks in your system. Too much water can prevent germination.

WATER EFFICIENTLY

Seeds should be moist but not soaked.

Water little and often. (example: 5x daily for 3 minutes each time)

Reduce irrigation frequency after seed sprouts.

Skip it

Save on seed, gardening and water

Let your lawn go gold for the winter

Get a rebate to replace grass with desert landscaping

know?

After you put seeds down, you can cover them with grass clippings to prevent evaporation and give them shade.
